

# NARRAGANSETT TERRACE YACHT CLUB

## 2010 Sailing Instructions

### Thursday Night Race Series

Starting Line: The Start / Finish line will be set somewhere between Allen Ledge, Conimicut Light and Bullock Beacon. An orange ball may be used for the pin end of the line. Any time the pin end of the line is not used as a turning mark, the starting line is closed.

Starting Sequence: **1800** Rhodes "19" **1815** Cruising Class WARNING SIGNAL  
**1801** Rhodes "19" **1816** Cruising Class PREPERATORY SIGNAL

**1804** Rhodes "19" **1819** Cruising Class ONE MINUTE WARNING

**1805** Rhodes "19" **1820** Cruising Class START

**Early Starters will be notified by a signal flag.**

Courses: The course board on the Committee Boat will designate class and course to be sailed. "P" OR "S" after the class designation will indicate port or starboard rounding. "I" indicates the pin end of the Start/Finish line, "Z" indicates a mark placed at Allen Ledge. Government marks will also be used.

Shortened Course: The Race Committee may shorten the course at any time before the first boat reaches the new finish line. Notice will be given by flying the "S" flag on the Committee Boat and two (2) sound signals.

Time Limit: 2100 hours

Penalties: Cruising Class will use the 20% scoring Penalty. A yellow flag must be flown.;  
Rhodes 19 Class will use the 2-Turn (720°) Rule for fouling another competitor  
and the One (1) Turn (360°) Rule for touching a mark.

Protests: You must notify the Race Committee of you protest immediately upon finishing.  
A protest form must be filed within one hour after the last boat finishes the  
Race. This changes Rule 61.3 .

Scoring: The Low Point System will be used. Time on Distance will be used  
For the Cruising Class.

Qualification: 8 Races are scheduled for each serie, 5 races from each series will be  
needed to qualify. Overall scoring will count the best 5 qualifying races  
from each series, or 60% of the races sailed. This changes Appendix A9.

Awards: All prizes and trophies will be awarded on a 1-3-5 basis. Multiple winners  
may receive combination prizes.

## **SPECIAL NOTICES**

Safety: When code Flag “Y” is displayed before or with the Warning Signal, life  
jackets or other adequate personal buoyancy shall be worn by all competitors.

Radio: The Race Committee will monitor channel **68** for safety purposes.

Observe: Bullock Beacon and Conimicut Light must be observed at all times.
